The year has got off to a great start, your children look really smart in their new uniform and they have settled well into their new classes. #### Apply for school places

It may be early in the year but if your child is in Year 6 you need to apply for secondary school places by **31st October.** The secondary schools are holding their open evenings so go and visit. Use <u>this link</u> to apply for places.

If your child was born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020 you need to apply for a primary school place. The deadline is **15th January 2024**, you can <u>use this link</u>.

Manford's Preschool offers 15 hour funded and 30 hour funded places. You can also 'top up' your 15 hours by paying for the extra 15. Call the school office to find out more- 0208 5002143.

#### **Missing School**

This is a reminder and a plea! Reminder, from our attendance policy:

"No holiday during term time will be authorised. Similarly, medical evidence will need to be provided when a child is absent just before or just after a school holiday. Redbridge LA will issue penalty notices for leave of absence taken without the permission of the Headteacher as a supplement to the existing sanctions currently available under Section 444 Education Act 1996 or section 36 Children Act 1989 to enforce attendance at school where appropriate.

This may be for:-

1. 12 unauthorised sessions in any 12-school week period.

2. Leave of absence taken without the permission of the Headteacher.

3. **Punctuality:** In cases of persistent lateness a Headteacher can apply to the LA to issue a penalty notice, though a notice will not normally be issued unless the child concerned has had 7 or more lates (after the close of registration) in a 6 school week period"

Whilst I appreciate the importance of seeing family and having time away together I am not able to authorise situations such as a visit to see a sick relative without proof that it is a **last minute booking.** For medical appointments abroad these should be booked in school holidays or should only require a day or two off school.

I know the thought of getting a penalty notice isn't nice, I would ask you not to expect your children to lie about their time off. It is really awkward for children when we are told they have been off sick and then they come back with a tan and have to pretend they haven't been on holiday!
