- sharing sexually inappropriate images of themselves



Whatsapp is the biggest problem and is rated 16- **for users over 16 only**-so your primary aged children should not be using it. There is a lot of information on our <u>website</u> about how to set parent controls and what to do if you are concerned. I have also included the Whatsapp guide with this newsletter. This week we marked Safer Internet Day and you will have received detailed information from Mrs James.
