




Writing: Children will be looking at a range of writing genres over the term including: narrative, letters, postcards, diaries, recounts and instructional.

The initial focus will be to use Capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in their writing. The children will be encouraged to use their knowledge of phonics in their writing and to work independently.

Everyday Materials

- Children will be taught to distinguish between an object and the material it is made from.
- Identify and name everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.
- Describe the properties of everyday materials.
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Art

Our focused artist this term is **Amedeo Modigliani**. Children will learn about differences and similarities in the work of Modigliani. They will learn different techniques and apply these to produce different patterns and textures from observations and illustration. Children will learn to develop a range of tone using a pencil and different drawing techniques. Finally, children will learn that primary colours can be mixed to make secondary colours and that shade, tint and tone can be made by adding black, grey or white to a colour.



History

Our topic this half term is **Ourselves**. Children will learn about different family types and know their place within a family. They will learn about events around the time they were born. We will compare their families to the Royal Family. Children will learn that the toys children play with now are different from the ones that their grandparents or the King played with. They will learn to identify the time period of a toy based on the material it was made from. We will then explore different types of homes within the UK and around the world. Children will learn what type of home they live in.

Computing

This half term, we will begin exploring computing through Purple Mash. We'll start with 2BeSafe – Being Safe in a Digital World, where we'll learn how to stay safe online. Following this, we'll be introduced to the Purple Mash platform, learning how to log in and create our own avatar profiles. In our Creative Computing lessons, we will:

- Use digital paint tools to create pictures
- Design a jigsaw puzzle on a digital device and share it for others to complete
- Create an interactive placing game using 2DIY
- Design images and incorporate them into our own digital games



Music

We will be practising songs for our harvest assembly in September. Please encourage your child to practise their lines, if they are given them.



PSHE

PSHE lessons will be taught in the form of JIGSAW lessons.

Our theme this half term is **'Being Me in My World.'** In all sessions the children will practice calming their minds before moving on to class-based discussions and activities.

RE

This half term the children will begin to learn about different religions and the symbols associated with them.

The children will consider and share information about the ways they welcome a new baby, before studying how different religions celebrate the birth of a baby.

PE

Our focus skills will be **Dance** - Across six lessons, pupils develop controlled movement at varying speeds, directions, levels, and strengths while responding expressively to weather-themed stimuli and musical accompaniment, culminating in partner work through mirroring, leading, and following. **Fundamentals 1** - To develop pupils' spatial awareness, movement control, and fundamental ball-handling skills through progressive activities that promote safety, coordination, and teamwork.
