




Literacy

Funnybones by Janet and Allan Ahlberg




Little Glow By Katie Sahota

Writing:


We will be;

- hold a pencil and use it with increased control
- developing our letter formation learn how each letter of the alphabet is formed
- share our ideas we have about our key texts
- begin recording the sounds we can hear in short sentences

Maths

We will;

- deepen our understanding of the numbers 1-5
- compare, compose and represent numbers to 5
- explore 2D shapes



Expressive Arts and Design

We will use different media to express ourselves;

- paint
- collage
- printing
- drawing
- colour mixing

We will be experimenting with;

- musical instruments
- singing and performing festive songs
- learn poetry and nursery rhymes

Understanding of the World

We will learn about different festivals;

Communication and Language

We will;

Phonics and Reading

The children will to develop and deepen their phonic knowledge by continuing our Phase 2 phonics, learning the names of each phoneme. We will then spend time recapping these sounds and reading words containing the sounds learnt.

While recapping the sounds, children will be encouraged to write words and read simple sentences which contain different focus sounds.

We will continue to be reminded that our school is a listening school

The expectation remains that we will be independent in our personal, social and emotional development as well as caring for our environment and belongings.
