


Spring One Term Year 1


English

Talk for Writing, we will learn and retell a story through actions, we will then innovate it and create our own story.


Maths

Phonics

Children will continue blending phase 4 words. Children will explore reading and spelling polysyllabic words (words containing more than one syllable) and words which have adjacent consonants, such as trap, string and milk. Some children will then begin Phase 5, where they will learn alternative sounds, such as 'ai' (train), 'ay' (tray), 'a-e' (make), a (basic)

Science

This term we are looking at Animals including Humans.

We will learn basic human body parts and examine human growth. We will learn about the five senses and the body parts they are associated with.

As part of our ongoing seasons unit, we will learn about the weather and which weathers are linked with each of the seasons.

Art & Computing

In Art this half term we will be studying the work of different illustrators.

In Computing (Purple Mash), children will learn to use software tools to group and sort objects, helping them understand how data is organised. They will explore that data is information which can be collected and represented visually through pictures. By the end, they will gather simple data themselves and present it in a pictogram.

Geography

Within Geography this term we are learning about Our Country, including countries of the United Kingdom as well as human and physical features of England.

We will compare similarities and differences between towns and villages and identify famous landmarks across the country.



Music

Within Music pupils will be able to show slow and fast using their bodies, voices, and instruments. They will perform songs from memory with a singing voice, keep a steady pulse, and play or sing with accuracy. They will observe others and respond appropriately, moving, speaking, singing, and playing to demonstrate slow and fast beats.

PSHE

PSHE lessons will be taught in the form of JIGSAW lessons.

Our theme this half term is;
'Goals and Dreams.'



RE

We will be learning about what it means to be a Christian and some of what Christians believe.

We explore the church as a place of worship as well as examining different stories from the Bible and considering what they might teach Christians.



PE

We will be learning to push the ball gently with a racket, keeping it under close control by concentrating and trying out our own ideas. We will also learn to work together by sharing equipment and supporting one another.

Alongside these skills, we will be learning to explore dance styles such as salsa, developing our rhythm, coordination, and expressive movement.
