Science

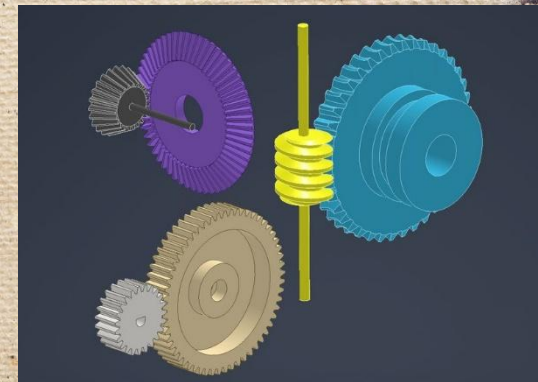
This term we are looking at Animals including Humans.

Geography

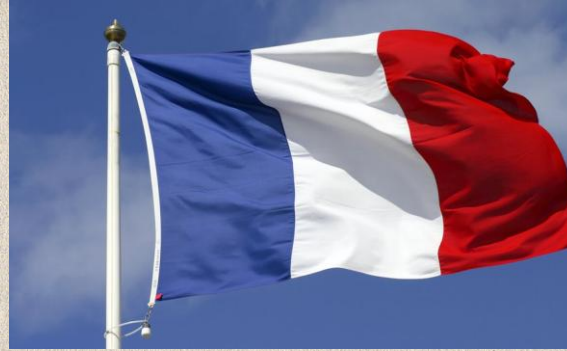
Within geography this term we are going to be looking at South America.
