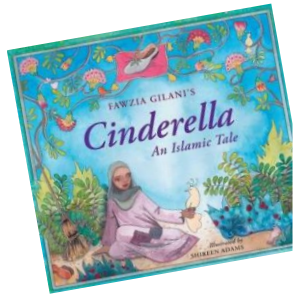


# Summer One in Year 1

## English

This term we will be looking at different texts including:



## We are reading...

This term we are reading a selection of Cinderella Stories from around the world and *The Day the Crayons Quit* by Drew Daywalt.

We will also focus on different writing genres:

- Character descriptions
- Story writing
- Letter writing
- Expressing our own opinions
- Comparing and contrasting

## Maths

In Maths this term we will be starting our Multiplication and Division unit, including counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will look at different ways to make equal groups including grouping and consolidate our knowledge of doubling and halving. We will also be looking at Fractions - finding halves and quarters of quantities.

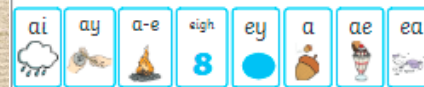
## Science

We are starting a new topic on Plants. We will be learning about the different types of Garden and Wild Plants. We will learn to name plants and put them into groups. We will also plant our own vegetable seeds and observe the changes as they grow.

## Phonics

We will be focusing on revising our Phase 5 sounds and making links to sounds we have already learnt. Children will become confident in knowing all their alternative sounds.

## History

In History we are learning about the history of Transportation. Children will learn about different modes of transport in the U.K. as well as the history of boats, trains and planes.



## Art

In Art, we are focusing on the work of artists Henri Rousseau and Claude Monet. We will learn about their most notable work before recreating our own masterpieces.



## Music

We will explore rhythm through fairytales, learning to chant together, change their voices for different characters, and respond to simple hand signals when using instruments. We will choose sounds to match moments in a story, read very simple rhythmic patterns, and clap or play along with spoken phrases.

## PSHE/RE

PSHE lessons will be taught in the form of JIGSAW lessons.

Our theme this half term is; 'Relationships'.

In RE we are learning about Churches and how they are important to Christians.

## Computing

We will start learning the basics of coding. Using simple block coding, they'll discover that computers follow clear instructions and that they can create these instructions themselves. They'll explore how to make things happen on screen, understand what an event is (like clicking or pressing a key), and begin to read what simple code does. For our 2BeSafe Online: we will be looking at Online Bullying and Managing Information Online.

## PE

Children will be developing both their dance and ball skills this term. In dance, they'll explore how bodies move, creating simple sequences and expressing ideas through action. They will also build key ball skills such as sending, receiving and dribbling, learning how to control a ball with growing accuracy.
