

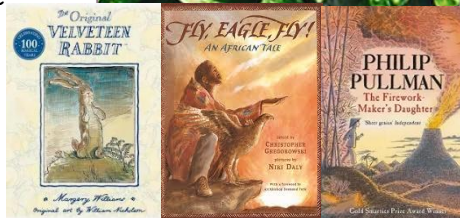
Summer One Term Year 3

English

We begin this half term by reading *Velveteen Rabbit*, where we will learn to write an internal monologue. We will then explore a narrative African tale "Fly Eagle Fly", by discussing the key features and what makes writing effective.

Finally, we move on to "The Firework-Maker's Daughter". We will explore descriptions within the story and look at features of adventure writing before writing an alternative ending.

Maths

This half term we will be learning about fractions of quantities. We will learn how to find unit and non-unit fractions of an amount and solve fraction word problems.

We will be adding and subtracting with money, giving and calculating change and converting money using pounds and pence.

Finally, we will recap time and learn how to tell the time to the nearest minute. We will use am, pm and 24-hour time notation. We will learn how to calculate time durations and compare these.

History

The Romans and their impact on Britain

We will:

- understand what it means to be a historian
- know who the Ancient Romans were
- explore how Rome developed into an Empire
- know how the Roman Empire affected Britain
- learn what made the Romans so powerful.
- understand Roman beliefs and practices
- learn about the lives of everyday people
- understand why the Roman Empire collapsed
- learn about the Roman legacy that remains
- debate the importance of the Roman Invasion of Britain

Science

Rocks and Soils

We will learn:

- how to sort different rock types
- find out how rocks are formed
- test the properties of rocks
- explore how we use rocks in a variety of different ways.
- how fossils are different to rocks
- how fossils are formed.
- about different soil types

Art

Roman Art using clay and mosaic

We will:

- study Edmonia Lewis and discuss her work
- create our own clay, coil bowl
- explore different Roman mosaics
- discuss our likes and dislikes
- design and create a Roman mosaic
- evaluate our art work

RE

How different faiths are expressed through various art forms

We will:

- study the art and think about the various characters, colours and symbols within a variety of pieces
- look at different pieces of music that have been inspired by different faiths
- discuss the impact of the music and the stories they depict
- create our own piece of art work inspired by a faith

Music

Jazz

We continue to use Kapow to deliver our music sessions.

This half term we will be learning about ragtime style music, traditional jazz and scat singing. Children create a jazz motif using a swung rhythm.

Computing

Spreadsheets

Children will begin by exploring basic data entry and then learn to using formulas and functions for data analysis. Students will apply this knowledge to create spreadsheets that model real-life scenarios and solve practical problems.

Online Safety - Fact or Fiction

Students will analyse and create "spoof" webpages to identify the common features and motives behind misleading content which can be found online.
