English

This half term we will be looking at the text: Windrush Child

Within English, we will also focus on different writing genres:

- Narrative
- Arguments
- Diary Writing
- Debates
- Settings
- Characters
- Letters
- Biographies
- Newspapers

Children will continue to learn to use the full range of punctuation taught at Key Stage 2.

In addition to the above, children will also learn about different word classes and how to understand these within a sentence.

Maths

This term we will be learning a variety of number and calculation methods/strategies. As well as revising the four operations and basic skills:

- Shape
- Position and Direction
- Decimals
- Co-Ordinates

Science

This term we are looking at Properties and Changing Materials.

We will look closely at different processes that impact on our daily lives, looking at both reversible and irreversible changes.

We will also be looking at different types of materials, their features as well as how they impact uses.

History

Within History this term we will be looking at The Windrush Generation and we will look at the historical and cultural short-term and long-term impacts, as well as reasons behind it taking place.



Art

Within Art, we will be looking at Trailblazing Women – with a focus on Sonia Boyce, Bridget Riley and Zaha Hadid.

We will research how these women have been influential to society and other artists, with particular emphasis on British Black Arts Movement (Sonia Boyce).

As a final project we will create a piece of digital artwork inspired by Bridget Riley.

Music

South & West Africa

Children learn 'Shosholoza', a traditional South African song, play the accompanying chords using tuned percussion and learn to play the djembe. They will also learn a traditional West African drum and add some dance moves ready to perform the song in its entirety.

PE

In PE this term we will be participating in Cricket lessons outside.

Indoor PE will be Gymnastics- counter balance and tension.

PSHE

As part of our PSHE unit this term we will look at 'Relationships'.

We will look closely at positive and negative relationships and how these impact on us and our lives.

Computing

In computing this term, we are looking at coding. This will include of the following:

To understand what a function is and how functions work in code.

To understand what datatypes are and how they are used when coding with variables.

To read code, predict outcomes and identify and fix bugs.

RE

Within Religious Education this term we will look at different aspects to answer the question of 'What does it mean to be a Muslim?'
