English

We will be reading books written by Margret Wild, Ron Brooks and Anne Fine.

We are reading...



We will be exploring internal monologues of characters, behaviour traits and empathising with their actions. We will delve into the meaning of friendship for two characters in detail. We will also be exploring a different countries culture & weather and we will be comparing this with England.



Maths

Statistics – Children will be using their knowledge of counting in 2, 5, and 10 to read, draw and interpret pictograms, bar charts and graphs

Position and Direction – Building upon their knowledge of fractions children will learn how to make and recognise turns that are quarter, half and whole. Both clockwise and anti-clockwise.

DT

Sewing

We will study how to join materials by sewing. Children will learn how to thread a needle and how to plan, design and create a product which has appeal for their intended user. They will then evaluate the product against their prototype.



Science

Plants – Children will be continuing to explore how plants grow, what they need to stay healthy, and learn to identify parts of plants and trees through observation, planting activities, and simple experiments.



Geography

The Environment

Children will learn to identify causes and effects of climate change. They will learn how to protect the environment through recycling and other materials such as solar panels. They will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to the greenhouse gases and climate. They will identify non-renewable and renewable energy sources.



RE

Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

The children will be building on their knowledge of Islam and what Muslims believe. They will explore artefacts used for prayer and explore mosques and the role they play in Muslims lives.

Music

Pitch (Musical Me)

The children will learn to sing in a high and low pitch through playing games to spot the patterns. They will begin to read notation and spot missing notes while building confident early musicianship.



PSHE

Changing Me

Children will learn to recognise the physical and emotional changes that happen to their bodies as they get older. They will recognise the differences between male and female bodies and use correct vocabulary.

Computing

Purple Mash (Coding)

The children will build upon their knowledge of algorithms and create a program using a series of different properties. They will learn what debugging is and to debug simple programs.



PE

Locomotion

Children will be taught to move their bodies in controlled movements involving jumping, skipping and dodging. They will explore the skills needed to move at different paces, dynamics and speed. Children will refine their motions and work together to suggest ways to improve.
