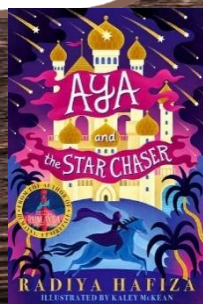
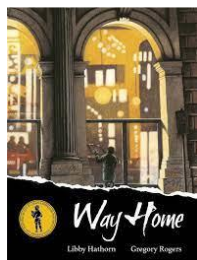
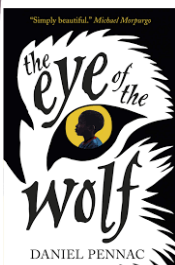


Autumn 1 in Year 5

English

This term we will be looking at two texts: *The Eye of the Wolf* and *Way Home*.

We are reading...



Within English, we will also focus on different writing genres:

- Oral performance/ storytelling
- Information texts
- Letters
- Diary entry
- Descriptive writing

In year 5 we will continue to work on the children's VIPERS skills in our reading sessions.

We will be starting the year reading *Aya and the Star Chaser*.

Children will also be focusing on their skills in unpicking texts in our comprehension focused lessons.

Maths

This term we will be covering a variety of number and calculation methods/strategies. As well as revising the four operations and basic skills, children will be developing their methods in these areas:

- Place Value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions

Science

This term in science, we will be exploring **Properties and Changes of Materials**. Children will investigate a wide range of everyday materials, learning to identify their different properties—such as hardness and conductivity.

Throughout the unit, pupils will take part in hands-on experiments to observe how materials can change. They will explore reversible changes, like melting and evaporating, as well as irreversible changes, such as burning or mixing substances to create new materials.

Art

Within art we are exploring the Ancient Greeks.

We will be using Ancient Greek art, architecture and myths as inspiration to create a range of pieces including:

- Greek God and Goddess collages
- Greek pottery style stamped pieces
- Greek Parthenon sketch



History

Within history this term we are going to be archaeologists who will be learning about the History of Ancient Greece.

We will be looking into this civilisation and its position to the rest of history recognising eras from the past we have studied.

We will look at artefacts, how these have been used to inform us in what we know today. We will be also looking at: Greek Gods, Athens vs Sparta, their legacies and focusing on the daily life of a child.

French

In our first unit this year in French we are focussing on how we greet each other and give personal information.

We will be looking further into family life, siblings, where we live as well as day to day life.

We will be working on our oracy skills in practising verbal pronunciation with our peers.

Music

This term our topic is Composition and Notation, which we will be exploring under the theme of Ancient Egyptians.

Children will identify the pitch and rhythm of written notes and experiment with notations, notating their compositions in different ways to help develop their understanding of staff notation.

PSHE

As part of our PSHE unit this term we will look at being me in my world.

As we start a new year we will focus on our goals, aspirations and the rights of a child. The children will be exploring their responsibilities and what it means to be a citizen of their country.

Computing

In computing this term, we will begin the year with designing and creating interactive quizzes using Purple Mash's 2Quiz tool. Children will be working independently and in groups to review their quizzes before finalising their product.

We will then move on to looking at databases. Where the children will design and create their own databases and use these to solve problems.

In our 2BeSafe sessions children will be exploring:

- Self-image & identity
- Online Relationships

PE

In PE this term we will be focussing on two different sporting activities: Gymnastics and Football.

In football we will be focussing on passing, shooting and eventually game play practising skills and knowledge.

In gymnastics we will be learning about rolling, jumping and mirroring to create paired and group performances.
